

## **Abandoned Game Procedure**

If any game is abandoned by the referee for any reason, the Coach, Manager or MC duty person must immediately call the Competition Secretary with the following information:

- 1. Why the game was abandoned.
- 2. How many minutes into the game it was abandoned.
- 3. Who were involved officials, spectators or players?
- 4. A written report must be made by the coach, manager, captain and marshal, spectator or anyone directly involved, clearly stating what happened. Please use the <u>incident</u> <u>report form.</u>
- 5. These reports then need to be handed to the Competition Secretary as soon as possible so they can be correlated and handed into Nepean by 5pm on Tuesday following the incident.
- 6. If the abandoned game is at our home ground, the committee member on duty must also fill out an incident report.
- 7. The team involved in the abandoned game <u>MUST</u> stand down until the incident is heard by Nepean.
- 8. Any player whose name appears on the team sheet of the team involved <u>MUST NOT</u> upgrade to any other team until the matter is resolved.
- 9. The Competition Secretary must also notify the Club President as soon as possible.
- 10. The NDSFA Competition Secretary must also be notified as soon as possible.
