

Jewellery Policy.

- A player must not use equipment or wear anything that is dangerous to himself or another player including any kind of jewellery. This includes body and facial piercings, anti-discrimination bands, leather necklaces and any other loose wristbands.
- The taping of jewellery, including earrings and wedding rings, is not acceptable or allowed.
- Sweatbands may be worn.
- A medical bracelet or necklace may be allowed if in the opinion of the Referee it presents no danger. It can be taped or bandaged to the body to provide protection.
