

Playing Time.

- Players are to receive equal playing time across the season.
- Coaches and managers are to ensure that across the season players receive equal playing time. This may mean that playing time varies from match to match but it should even out across all games.
- Coaches and managers should keep rosters of playing time to ensure this rule is followed.
- Under no circumstances are players to be given extra playing time because they are considered to be the team's best player or at the other end of the spectrum, less time on the field because they are considered to be a weaker player.
- Parents are reminded that the equal game time is across the season and not for each game. Parents are also asked to take into consideration the difficulties in coaching/managing teams and discuss any issues with the coach or manager in a reasonable fashion.
- Any concerns regarding game time should be discussed with the coach or manager in the first instance and then brought to the attention of the Management Committee if there are still issues.
